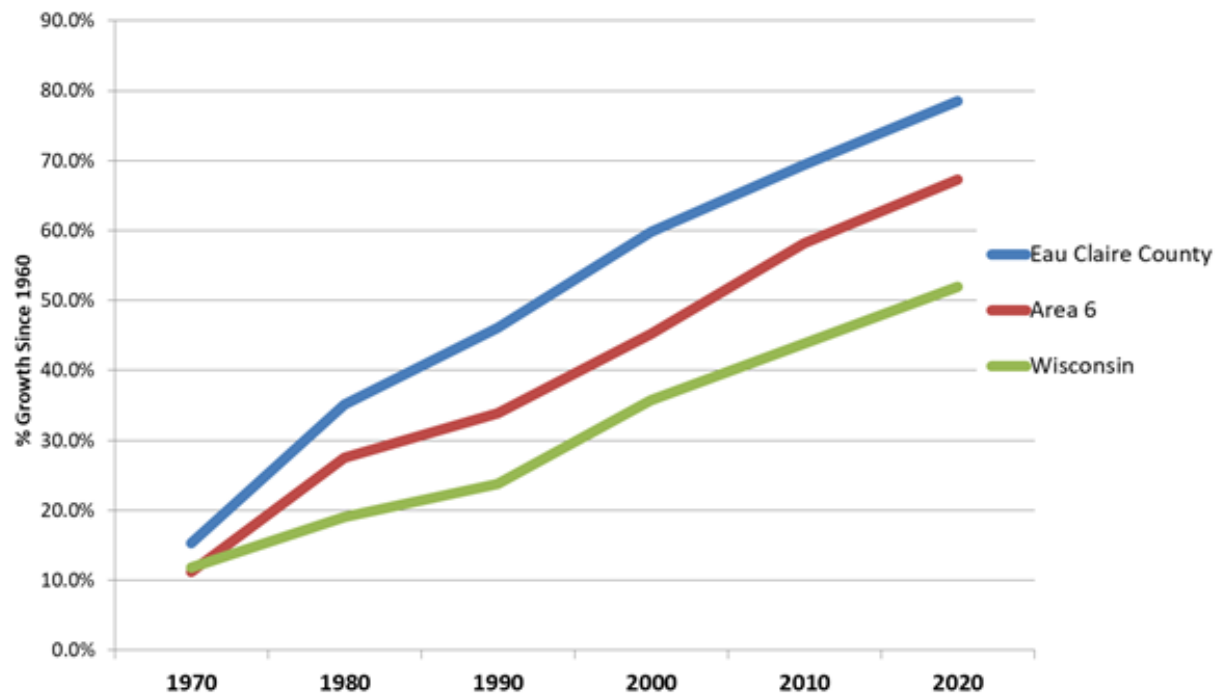

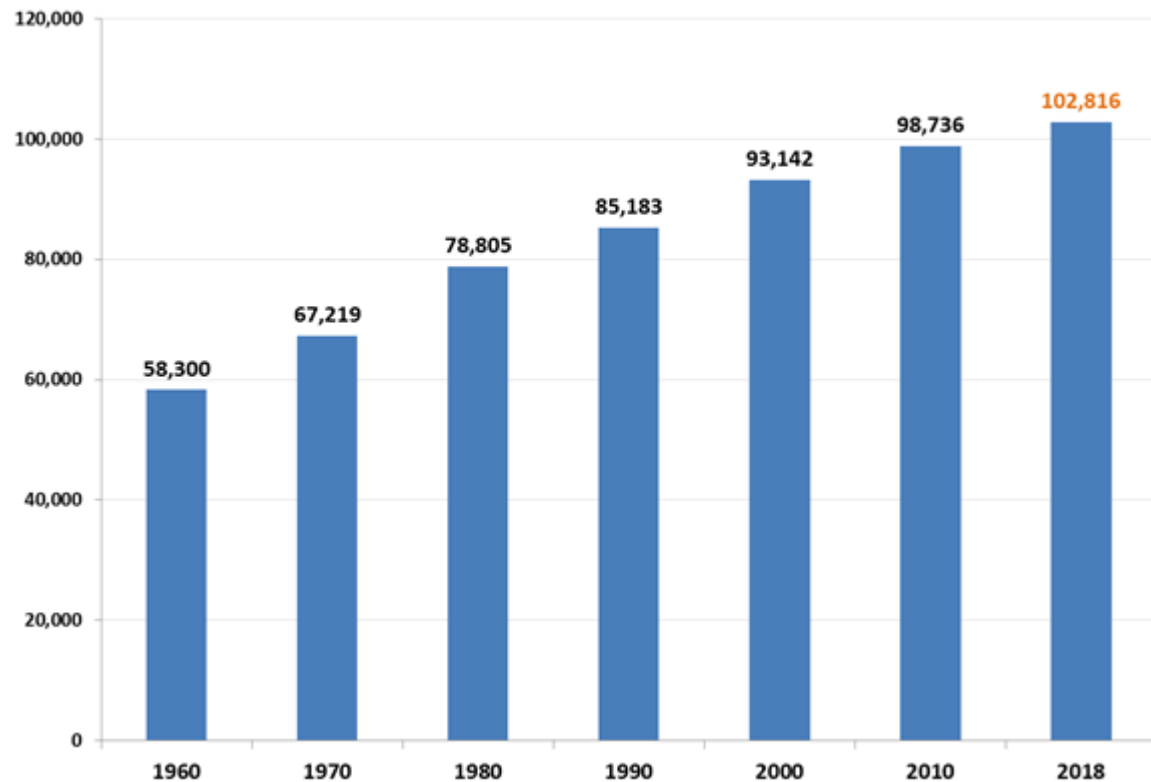

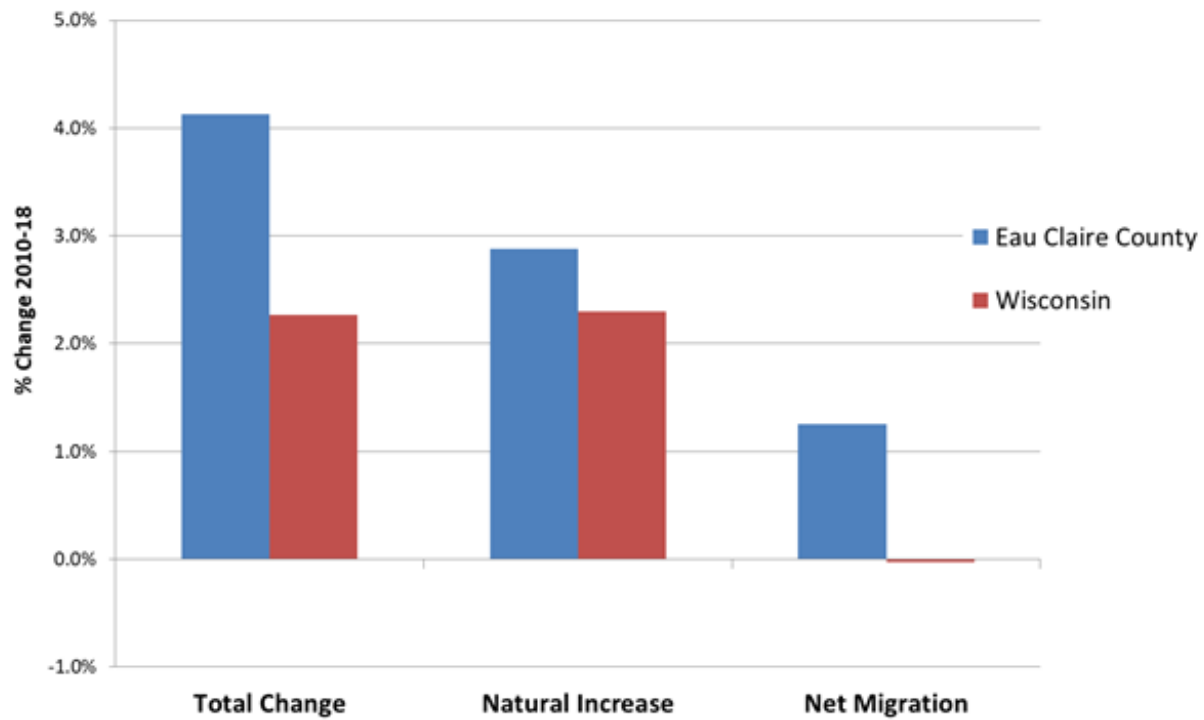
Eau Claire County Population Growth Since 1960 With Comparison to Area 6 and State of Wisconsin



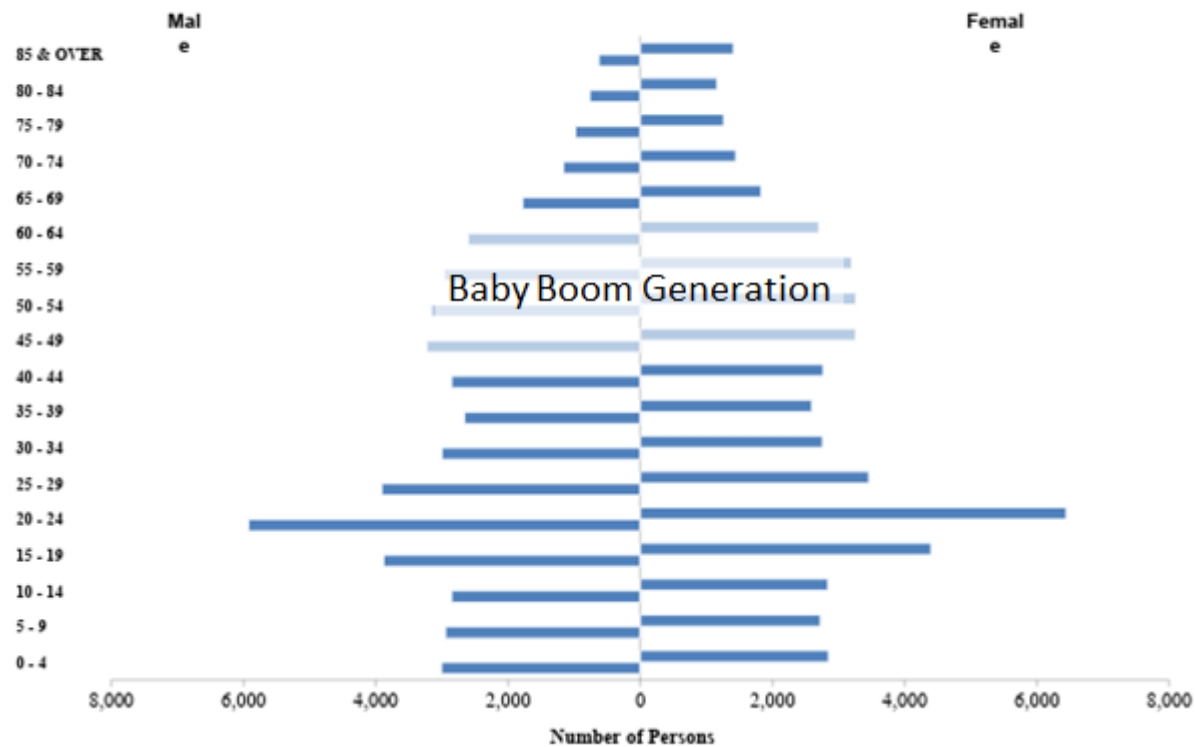
Eau Claire County Population Since 1960



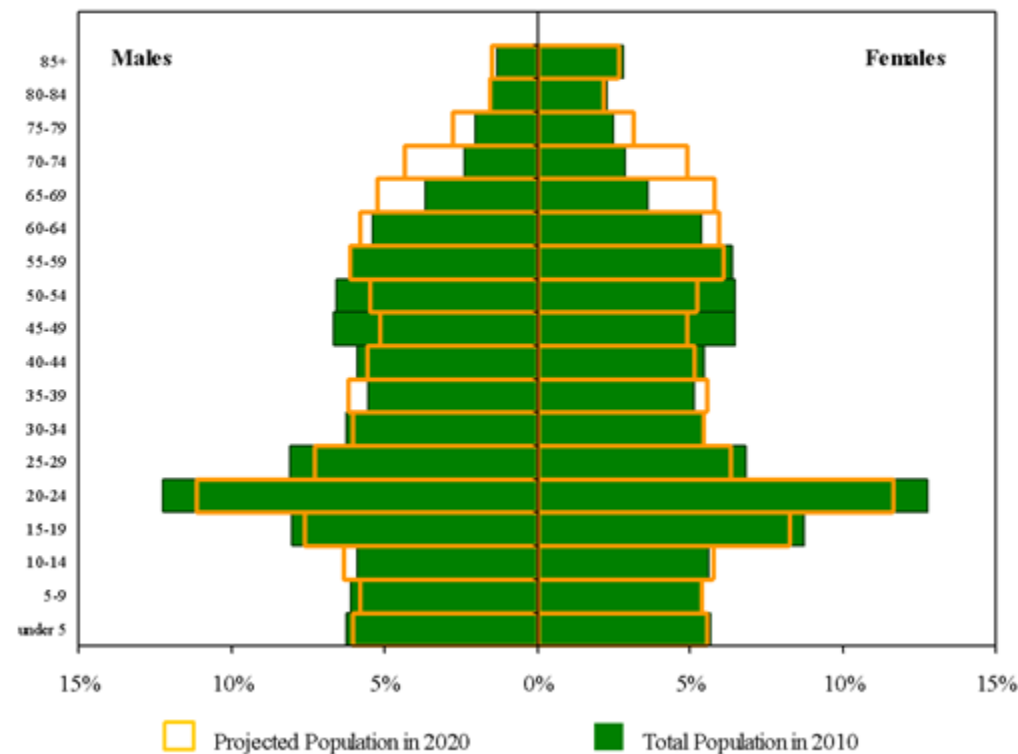
**Population Change, 2010-2018:

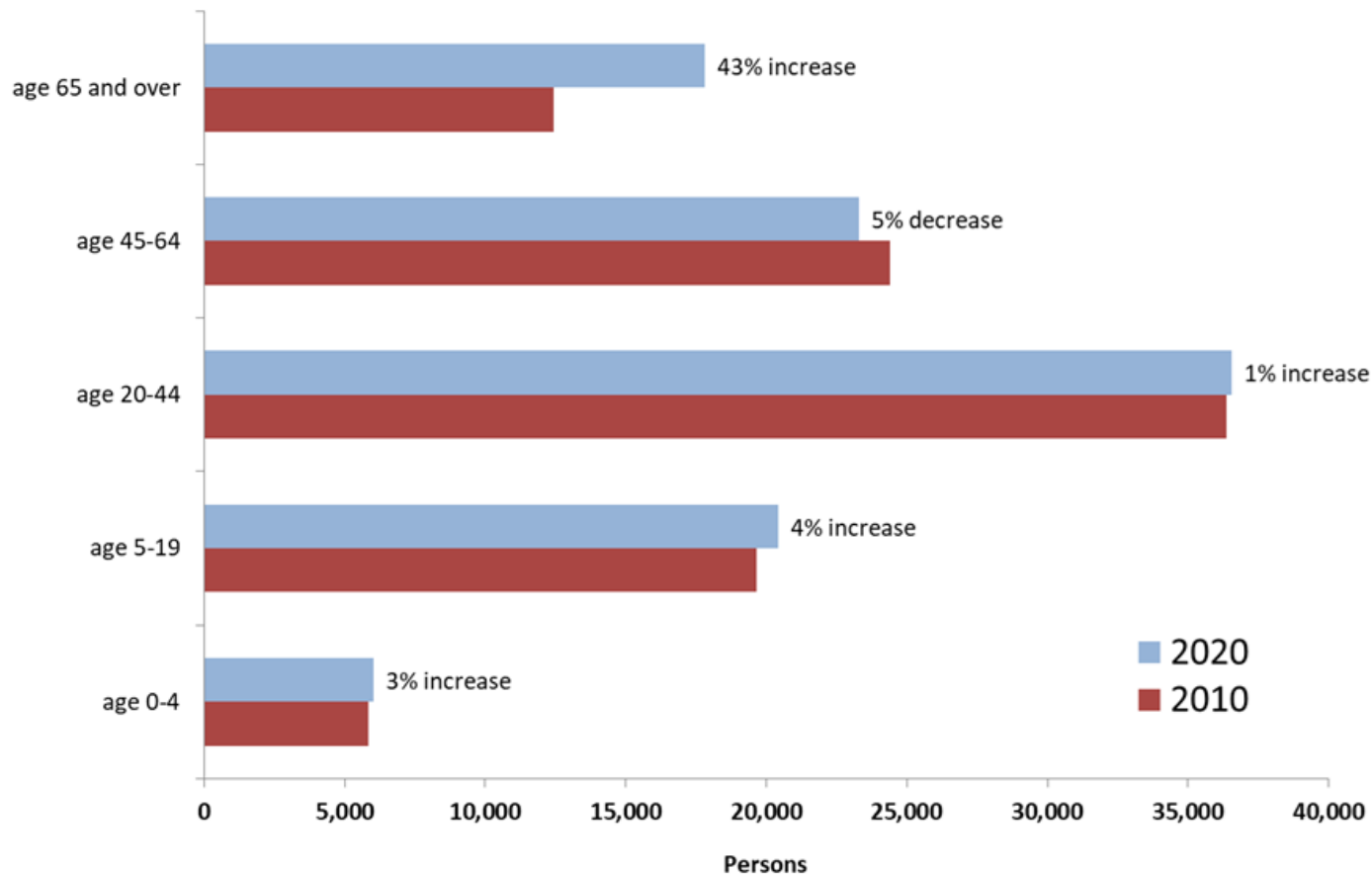


Eau Claire County Population by Age & Sex, 2010 & 2020

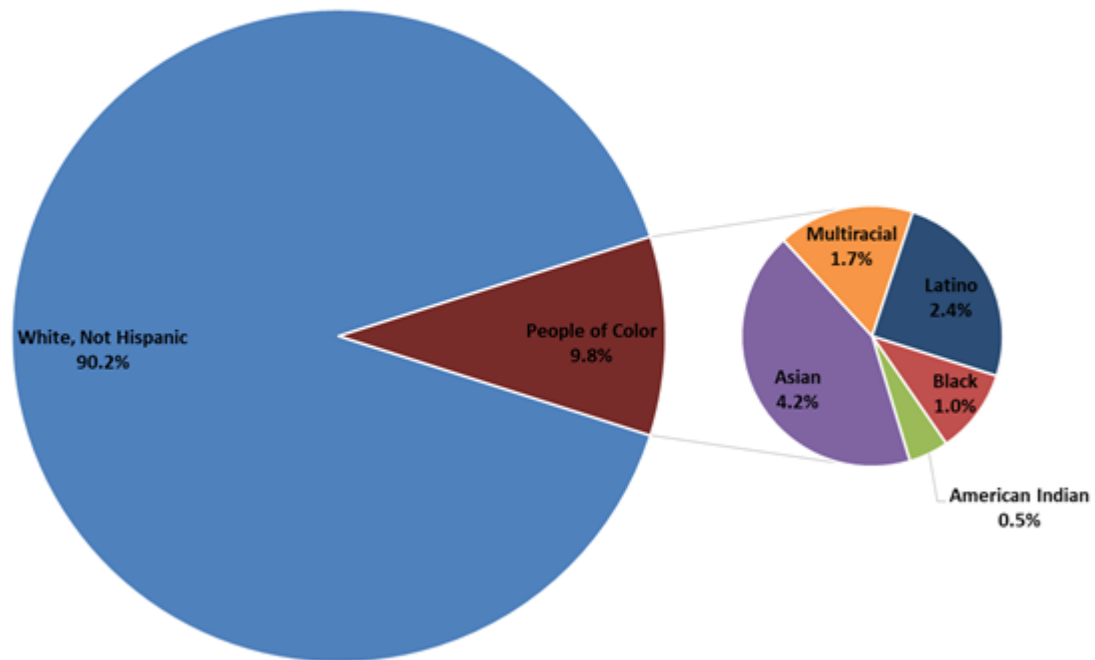


Change in Selected Age Groups, 2010 to 2020

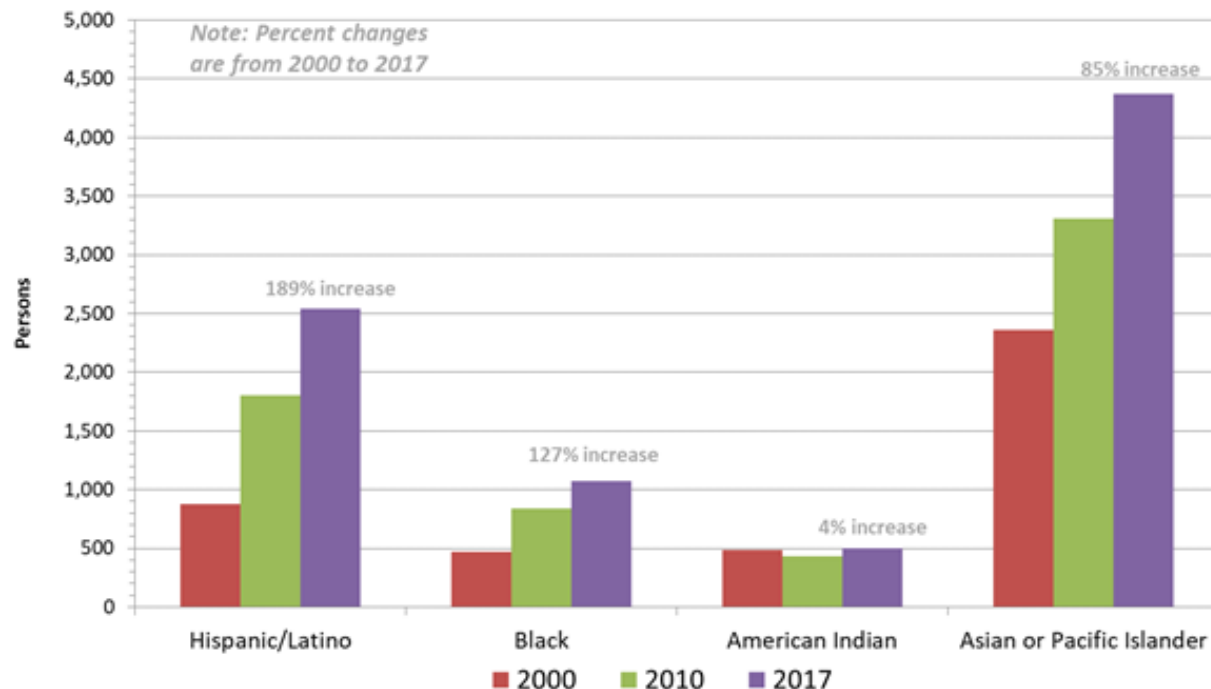

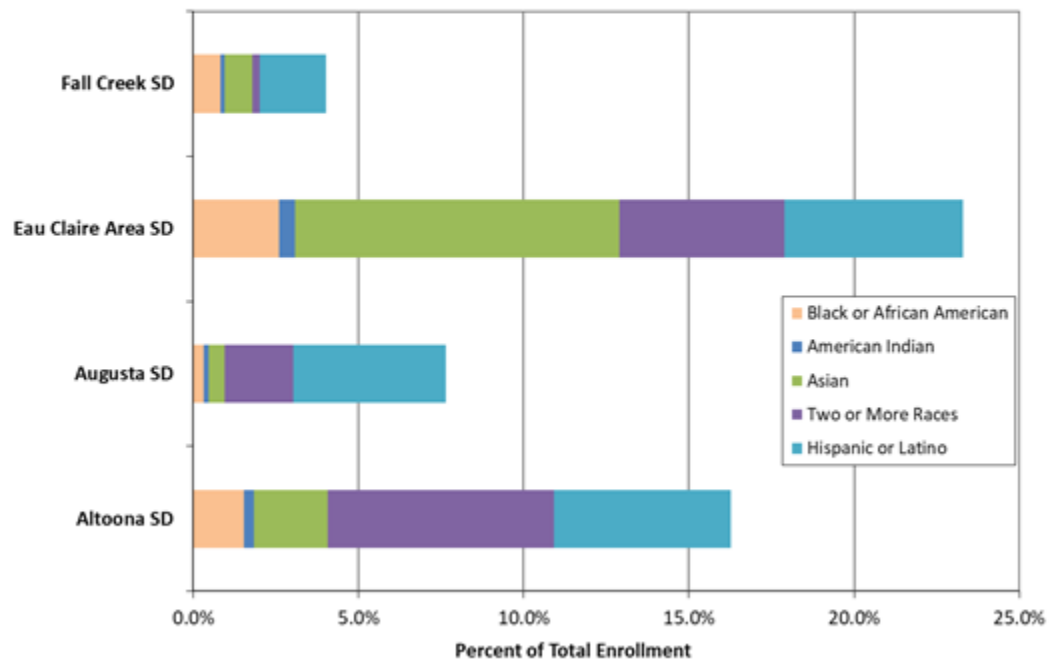
Eau Claire County Population by Race and Ethnicity, 2017



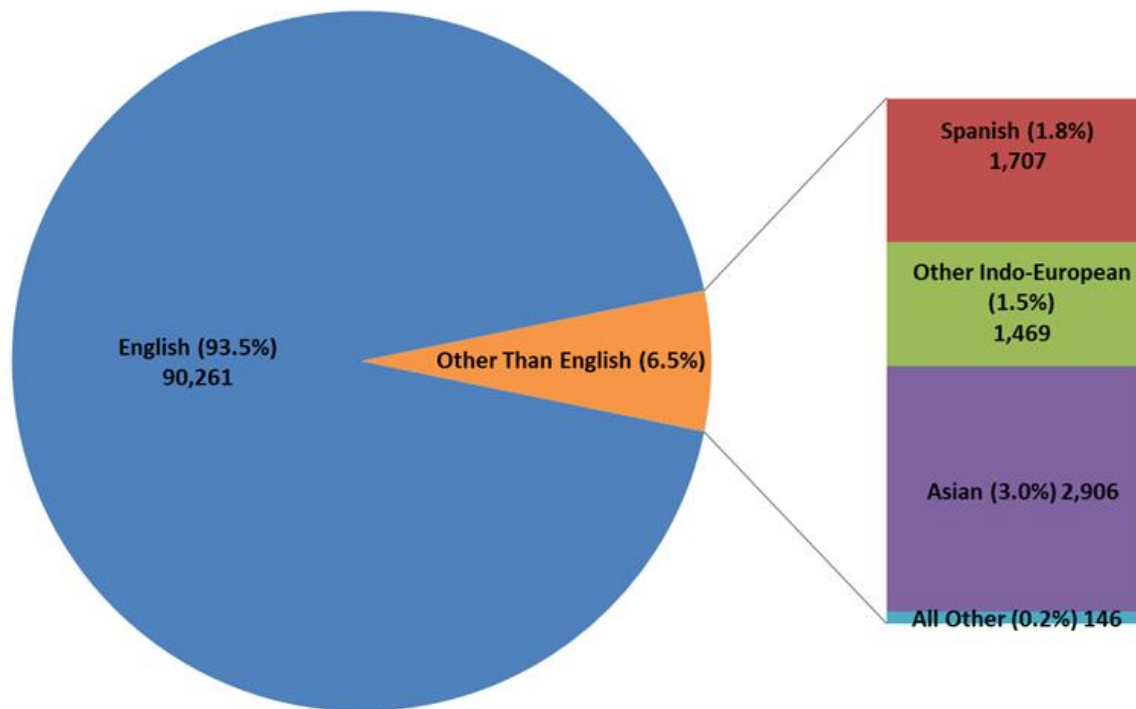
Growth of Race/Ethnic Populations, 2000 to 2017 Eau Claire County

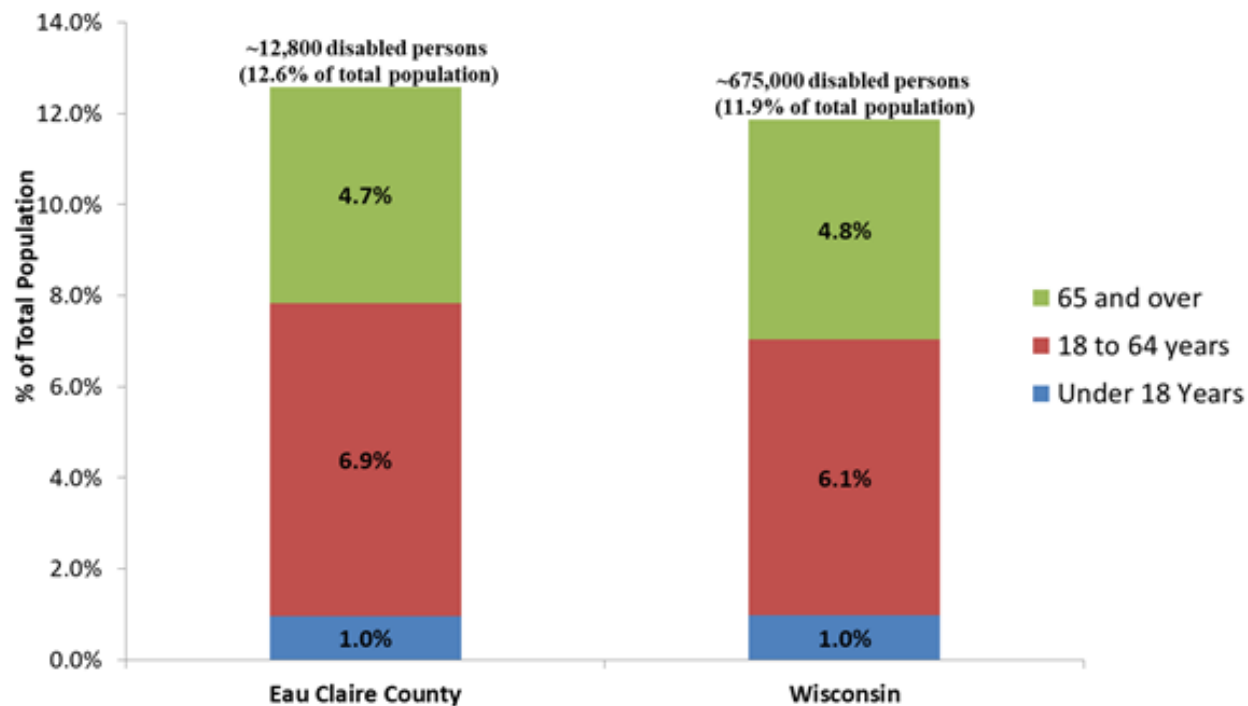


Language Spoken at Home for Persons Age 5 and Over, ACS 2013-2017

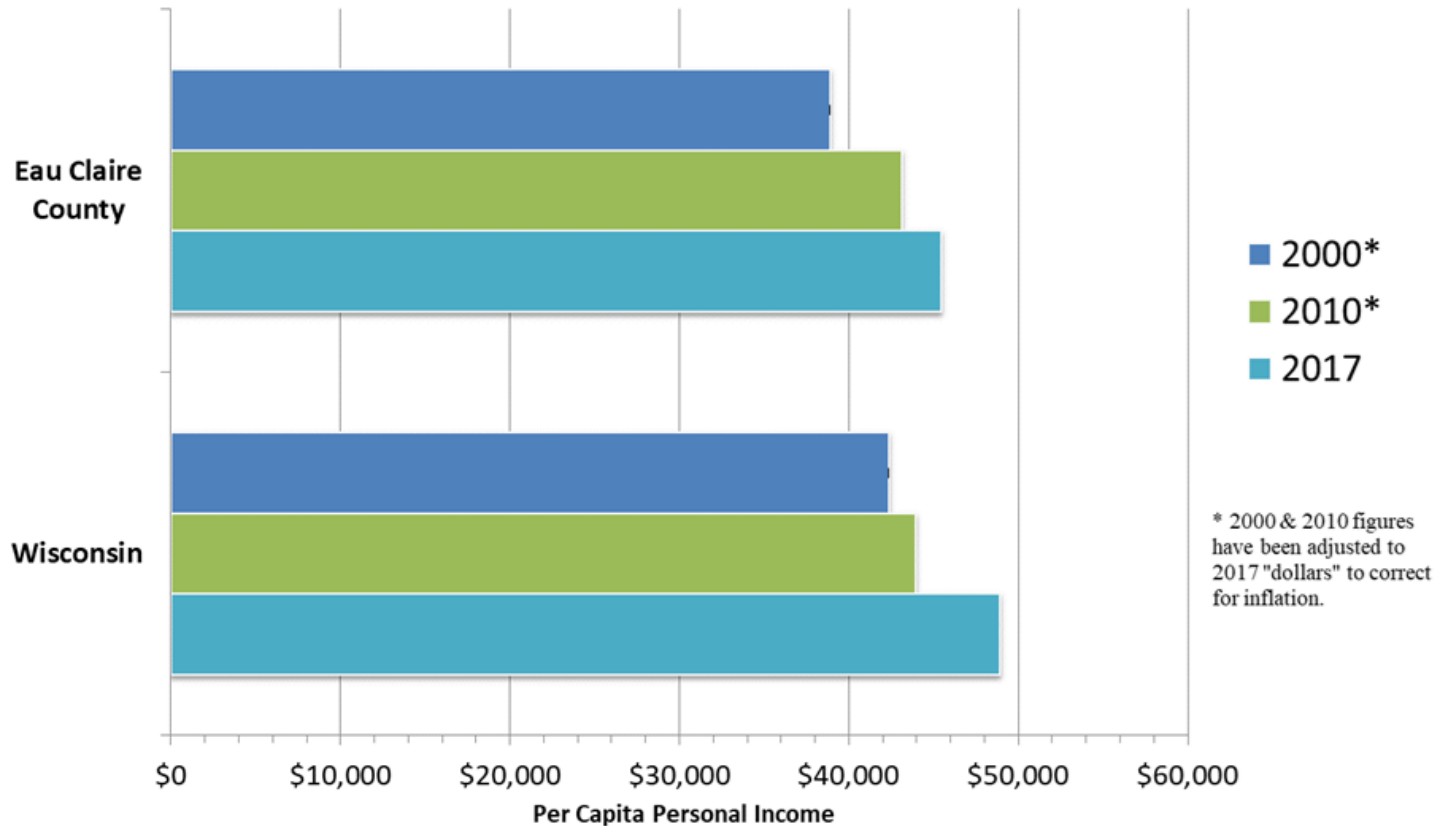


Persons with Disabilities by Age Groups, ACS 2013-2017

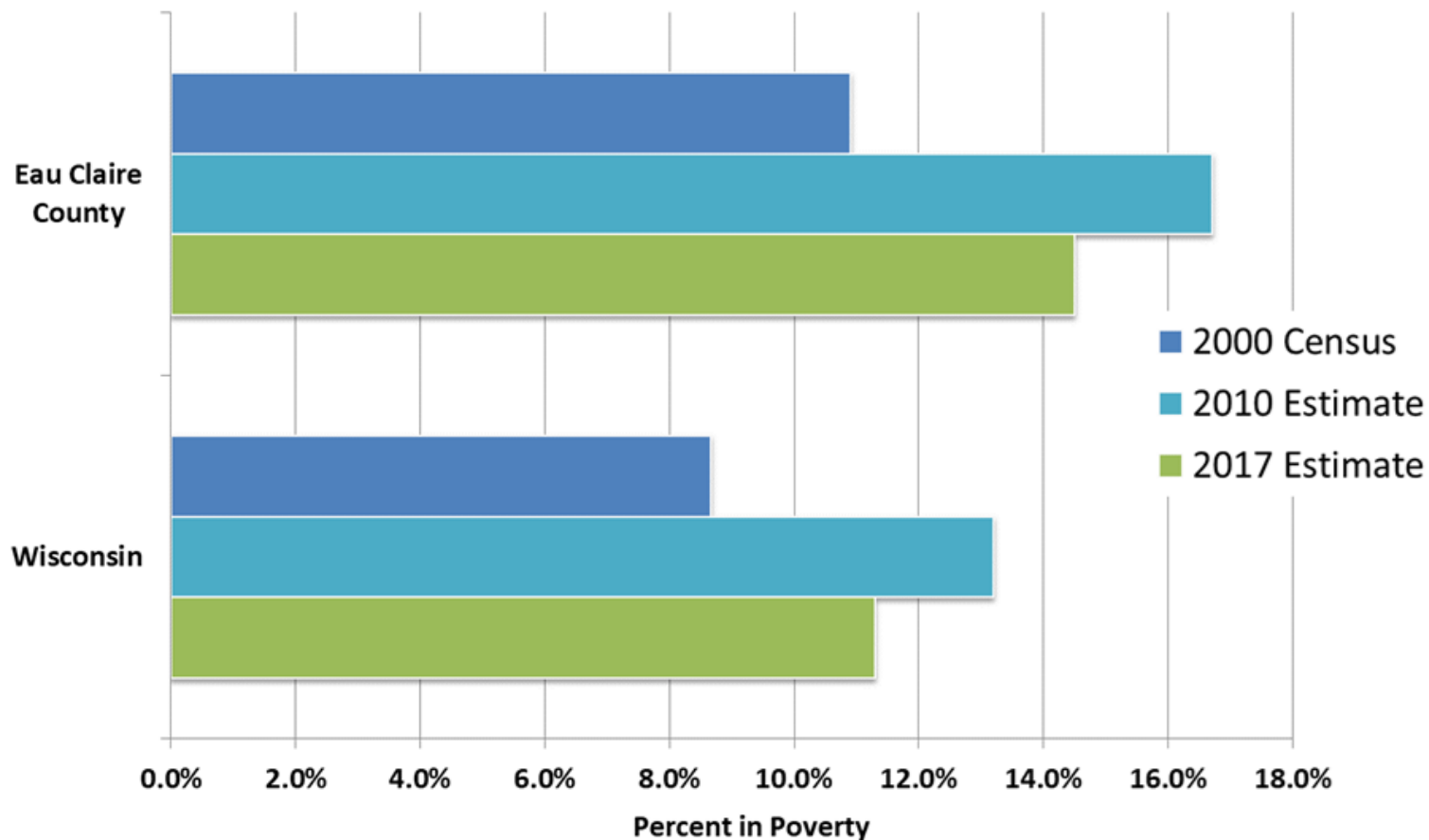


Per Capita Personal Income, 2000, 2010 & 2017 Eau Claire County and Wisconsin

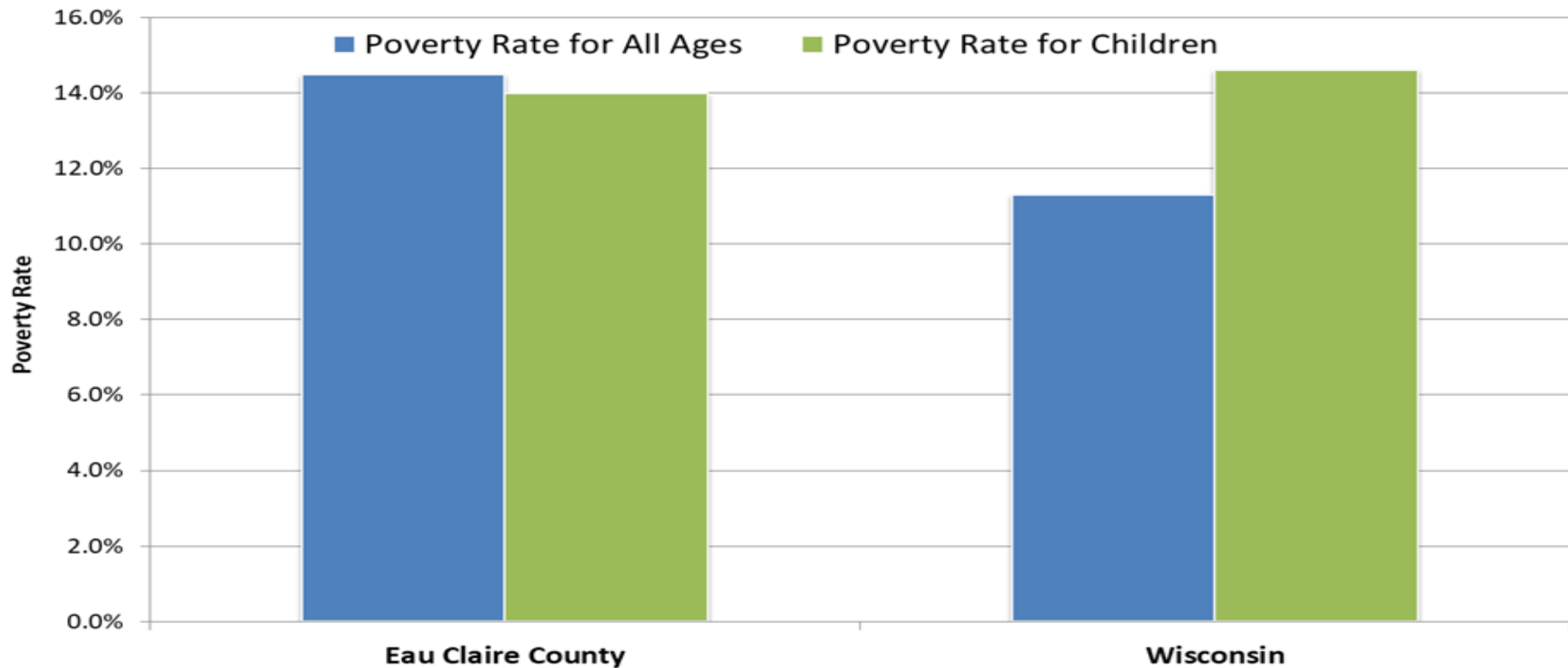


Percent in Poverty, 2000, 2010 and 2017

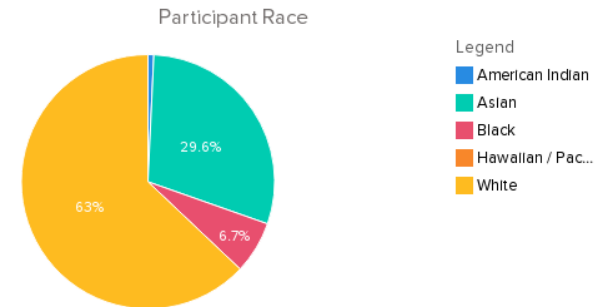

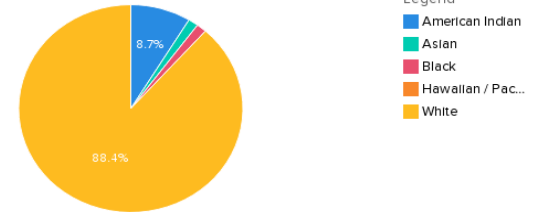

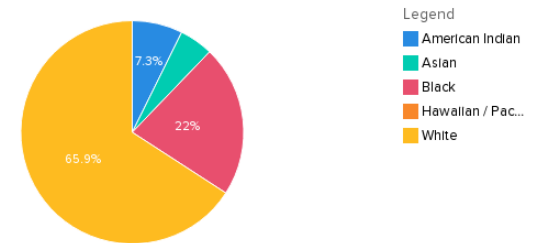

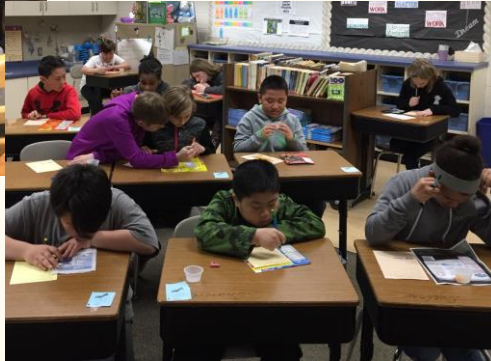

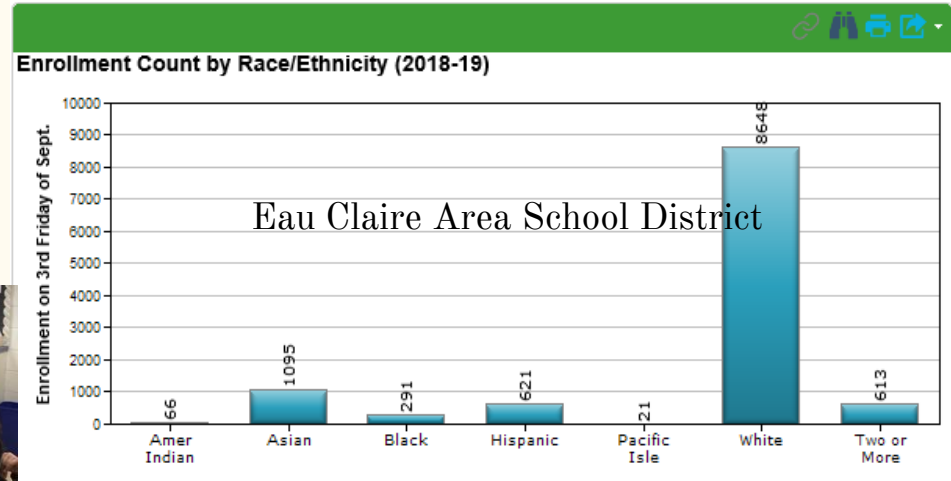

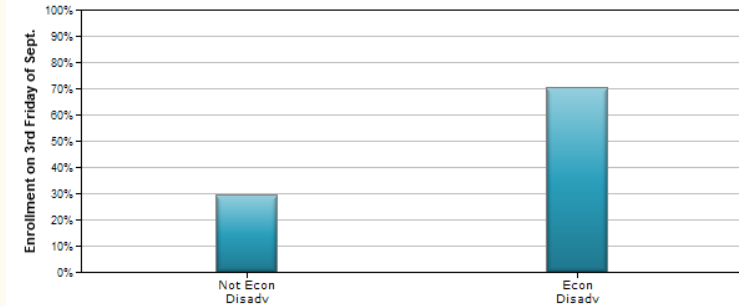

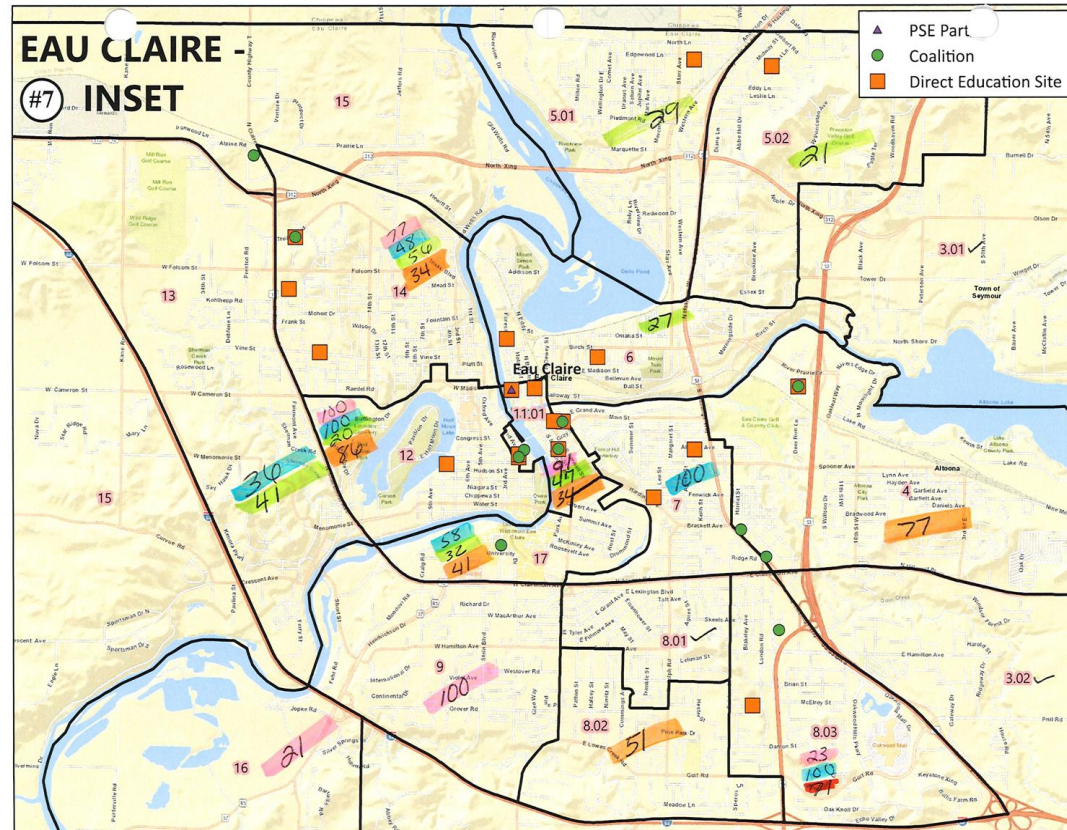
