Global Exploration Series

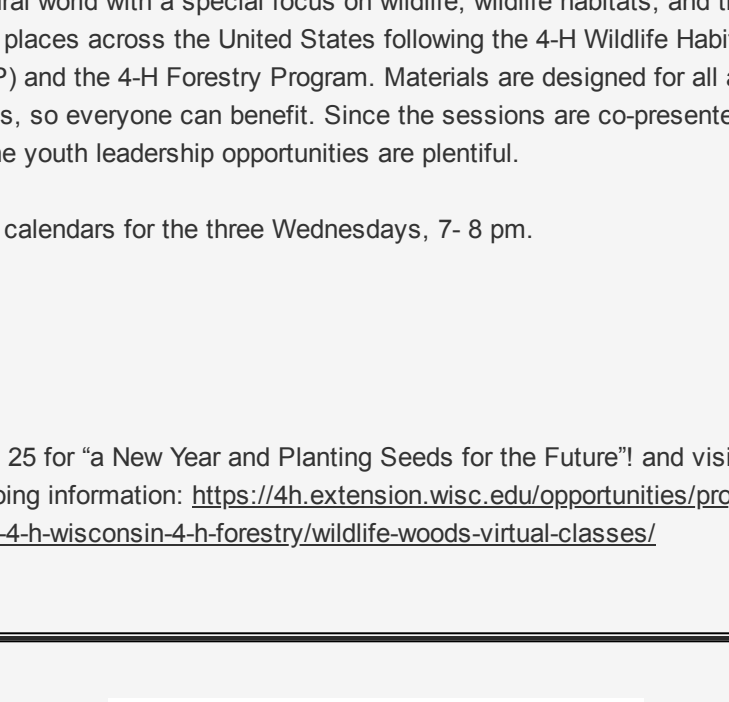

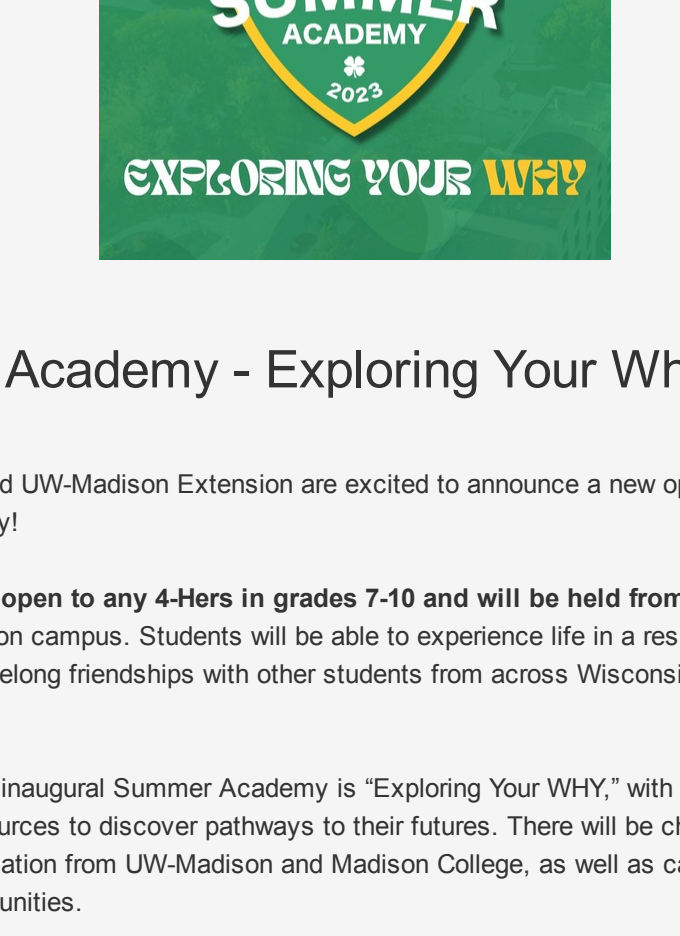

Drama Fest Results for Eau Claire County

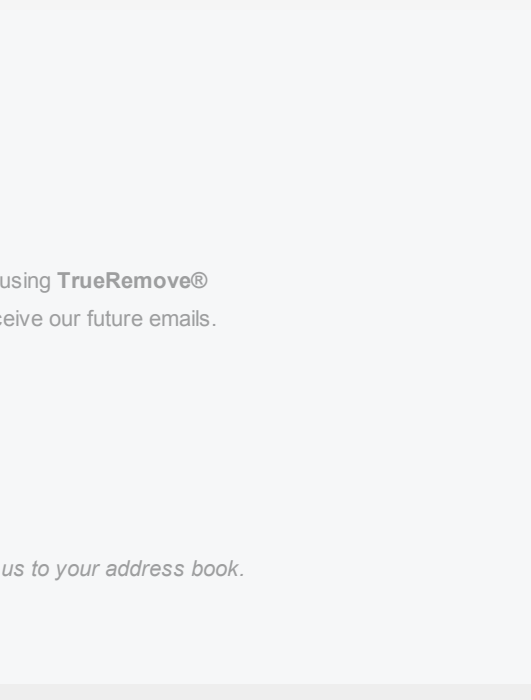
Congratulations to the Pleasant Valley Clovers for achievements in the 4-H Tri-County Performing Arts Fest Drama portion!
