
Eau Claire County 4-H Leaders Association




Leaders Association: Volunteers Needed



Annual Financial Report Work Night

Do you have questions about the Annual Financial Report? Come to the work night and get them answered. This is meant for club or group leaders and/or treasurers and/or those who have checkbook authorization. Don't wait until the last minute to work on this document! There will be snacks and a short presentation and then time to work and ask questions.



Annual Financial Reports Due to the Office August 21

All Chartered Groups and Clubs must complete this report.

You need to include:

- 1. Wisconsin 4-H Clubs & Groups Annual Financial Report
- 2. Wisconsin 4-H Clubs & Groups Audit Checklist
- 3. A copy of the checkbook and/or savings registry covering July 1 June 30
- 4. A copy of the bank statement ending June 30 or July 1 for each account. Any differences between the bank statement(s) and the ending balance reported must be reconciled and the reconciliation must be uploaded with the Annual Financial Report.
- 5. A current inventory of land, buildings, property, or project equipment with individual values of \$2,000 or greater.
- 6. If you brought in more than \$20,000 this year, you must include Monthly Treasurer's Reports

This process allows the Club or Group to qualify for federal tax-exempt status under the University of Wisconsin Board of Regents General Exemption Number (GEN) for Wisconsin Clubs and Groups.

Wisconsin 4-H Charter Application webpage. Any club or group that has a checkbook must submit this paperwork.

Picking Promises


