

It is almost time for your annual re-enrollment in 4-HOnline. The 4-H year is the same as the school year, so it is about to begin!

Basically, what will happen, is 4HOnline will restart or reboot at midnight on August 31. You will be able to re-enroll on Spetember 1. All adult volunteers and youth need to re-enroll. Please make sure you pay special attention to:

- 1. The grade listed for your child. Is it correct? If not, please correct it. Also, make sure all birthdates are correct. (For adults, you may need to e-mail us to change on our end.)
- 2. When adding or deleting projects, please be sure to remove any projects in which you will not be participating especially Cloverbuds/Exploring (Youth Development). If your child is no longer a Cloverbud, please remove that from the list. Before the fair, we ran a Cloverbud report. There were 4-Hers on there who were in their teens... Either there is confusion on what Cloverbuds is, or it's carrying over for people.

Please call the Extension office and talk to Rachel or Andy if you are having problems!

If you are an adult volunteer and need to take any new trainings or are due for a background check, please do those ASAP. You need to have all these completed before you work with the youth. Thank you!



Annual Financial Reports Due to the Office As Soon as You Can...

We have most of the reports, but are still missing a couple... All Chartered Groups and Clubs must complete this report.

You need to include:

- 1. Wisconsin 4-H Clubs & Groups Annual Financial Report
- 2. Wisconsin 4-H Clubs & Groups Audit Checklist
- 3. A copy of the checkbook and/or savings registry covering July 1 June 30
- 4. A copy of the bank statement ending June 30 or July 1 for each account. Any differences

between the bank statement(s) and the ending balance reported must be reconciled and the reconciliation must be uploaded with the Annual Financial Report.

- 5. A current inventory of land, buildings, property, or project equipment with individual values of \$2,000 or greater.
- 6. If you brought in more than \$20,000 this year, you must include Monthly Treasurer's Reports

This process allows the Club or Group to qualify for federal tax-exempt status under the University of Wisconsin Board of Regents General Exemption Number (GEN) for Wisconsin Clubs and Groups.

Wisconsin 4-H Charter Application webpage. Any club or group that has a checkbook must submit this paperwork.
