In this interactive experience, you'll:

1. Discover how wood carving traditions have evolved over time
2. Learn the difference between green wood and dry wood
3. Practice selecting and harvesting sticks for carving
4. Gain basic carving skills and create your own wooden flower masterpiece

Before you start carving, check out our knife safety tips and get ready to work side-by-side with your caregiver. This series is all about connection, creativity, and community—with plenty of opportunities to share ideas and celebrate your progress online. Youth can Zoom with Artist Derek Brabender on March 10th to share their work.

Winter Academy consists of three virtual sessions which provide youth with tools to set career and college goals, develop soft skills most important to employers, and build problem-solving skills. **By applying, youth agree to actively participate in all three sessions.** The sessions will not be recorded for viewing later. Once registration is closed, participants will receive a Zoom link, syllabus and materials needed to complete the sessions including a LEGO® Serious Play® Kit and a Clifton Strengths workbook for youth.
